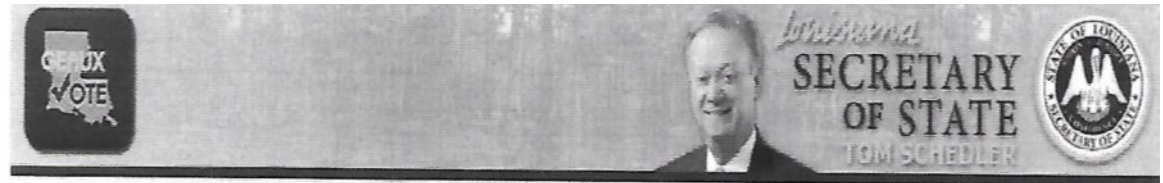


Helpful Tips for UOCAVA voters receiving their ballots electronically by email:

- You will receive an email from the Registrar of Voters office containing a link to your ballot.
- Click on the link and enter the requested information.
- Below is an example of the page you will see once you have entered the information.
- Return your ballot by mail, courier, or fax.

If you choose to print the PDF and mark the options manually, please check our [Candidate Inquiry website](#) before voting to see if any candidates on your ballot have been disqualified by a court order.

Document Links are only clickable for ballots that were sent by the Registrar of Voters in this email, and only if the marked ballot has not already been received by the Registrar of Voters. You will receive a separate email with a different link for any new ballots distributed.

PRINT PDF - Click to view your ballot(s) along with instructions for marking and submitting the ballot to your parish Registrar of Voters. You must have [Adobe Acrobat Viewer](#) to perform this action. To print the ballot, click the print button in Adobe Acrobat.

MARK ONLINE - Click to mark the ballot electronically. Once you have marked the ballot you will click the Print and Mail button to view your marked ballot along with instructions for submitting the ballot to your parish Registrar of Voters. You must have [Adobe Acrobat Viewer](#) to perform this action. To print the ballot, click the print button in Adobe Acrobat.

Ballot Numbers Prepare a separate envelope for each document according to its instructions. Each ballot number ends with a letter (A, R or U) and each letter type will have a different set of instructions. The ballot numbers are listed above, under the column Ballot Numbers, and printed on each Ballot and each Certificate and Waiver of Right to Secret Ballot. If you have multiple documents, make sure the Ballot and Certificate & Waiver for each envelope have the correct corresponding ballot numbers on them.

Viewed The date shown is the last date the document was opened.

Received The date shown is the date the ballots were received by the parish Registrar of Voters.

Status The current status of the ballots is displayed. Ballots can only be approved or rejected for counting by the Parish Board of Election Supervisors on election night. The final status is generally available within 7 days following an election. If the ballot is not counted, the reason will be displayed.

Please note the Election Dates!

When the primary election contains three or more candidates and there may be a run-off election, you may receive the ballot for the run-off election at the same time.

When this happens, the general election date appears at the top.
