Re: Last Day to Register for March 5th Election

The last day to register to vote for the Saturday, March 5th election in Caddo Parish is:

Wednesday, February 3, 2016.

All applications must be received or postmarked by February 3 in order to be processed for the election.

Caddo Parish residents may register online by visiting www.caddovoter.org and clicking on the "Online Voter Registration" button at the left side of the screen. Applicants will need the audit code on their drivers' licenses or state IDs to register online.

The Presidential Preference Primary election is a **closed party** election. Only voters registered as Democrats or Republicans will be eligible to vote for Presidential Nominees. The State Central Committees and Parish Executive Committees for the Democratic and Republican parties are also holding elections for their members. Voters registered as Democrats or Republicans may vote on the contested offices for these committee members. Only Democrats may vote for Democrats, and only Republicans may vote for Republicans.

Some voters, regardless of party affiliation, may vote on a special election for Court of Appeals Judge (2nd Circuit, 3rd District, Election Section 1A), on Greenwood Mayor, or on two propositions from Fire District 8; however, voters must be registered within one of these districts or towns to vote on the candidates.
