

# October 22, 2011

The April 2011 election included a special election for Parish Commissioner, following the resignation of Rose Wilson-McCulloch, and three propositions for the City of Shreveport.

The elections in Caddo Parish during the fall election dates of 2011 featured the regularly scheduled elections for parish officials and the Parish Commission members, plus all statewide officials, State Senators, and State Representatives. The election for Secretary of State was for the regular four-year term and the unexpired term.

The October 2011 election included five Constitutional Amendments and one proposition for the Parish Commission. There were also special elections in Caddo Parish:  
Shreveport City Judge - due to the death of Judge Randy Collins  
School Board Member – due to the resignation of Willie Burton  
Justice of the Peace, Ward 3 – due to the death of M.E. “Gene” Nichols, Sr.

The November 2011 election included run-off elections for State Senator (39<sup>th</sup> Senatorial District), State Representative (3<sup>rd</sup> Representative District), and Shreveport City Judge, as well as one Constitutional Amendment.

Unless otherwise noted, charts show only the Caddo Parish portion of results.
